Parties will please take notice that on Monday, August 23rd, at 11:30 a.m., in the courtroom listed above, the undersigned will make the following Motion and tender the attached Order scheduling this motion for the previously scheduled hearing on September 17, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.

MOTION

Petitioner, CAROLYN WATSON (MUSGROVE), by counsel, and by verification, moves the Court to hold the Respondent in contempt for his willful violation of the Protective Order.

In support of this Motion, the Petitioner states as follows:

1. The Petitioner states that the Respondent exercises Court Ordered Supervised parenting time with the Parties daughter at Safe Haven, for one day per week for one hour.
2. The Respondent missed a total of three (3) visits and has repeatedly received warnings for discussing the case in front of the minor child during the visitation.
3. During the Respondents' most recent visit during the week of August 10th, he learned that the minor child was about to start school.
4. The Respondent then left the visit and went across the street to the school where he appeared in the front office and requested a *car rider pickup tag and number* for the minor child.
